SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

American Legion: Must be the child or grandchild of a current member of the American Legion or who is currently serving in the United States Armed Forces.

AMVETS: Must be the direct descendant of an active duty member or an Honorably Discharged veteran of the U.S. Armed Forces

Marine Corps League: Must be the child or grandchild of an active duty, retired, or former U.S. Marine, FMF Corpsman, or a Marine or FMF Corpsman on active duty.

Military Order of the Purple Heart: Must be the child or grandchild of a veteran who was awarded The Purple Heart Medal.

Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW): Must be the child or grandchild of a member of the VFW at the time of the award.

VFW Ladies Auxiliary: Must be the child or grandchild of any member of any Folsom veterans organization listed at the time of the award.

BASIC REQUIREMENTS

- 1) **Must present proof of acceptance/attendance at a college, university, or trade school for enrollment during Summer/Fall, 2011.**
- 2) **Must submit a copy of the veterans military discharge document or military I.D. card.**
- 3) **Applications must be received at the Folsom Veterans Hall , no later than 5 PM, TUESDAY, MAY 4th, 2011.**
